Special Tournament General Rules

Game Length & International Tie Breaker (Juniors/Minors) - Games cannot end in a tie. No new inning will start after 75 minutes. When the time limit is reached, the current inning will be completed. International tie breaker rules will be used if game is tied after 7 innings or after time limit last inning. Under the international tie breaker, the last out of the last inning will be placed at second base with 1 out to start each inning. Complete Innings will be played this way until a winner is determined.

Determining home team - The umpire will do a dual coin flip to determine who has the choice of being the home team. The umpire calls up each team's coach and/or captains together before the game at home plate. The umpire then picks 1 team as heads and the other team as tails. He/she then flips the coin. The winning team of the first coin flip gets to call heads or tails for the second umpire coin flip. The winning team on this flip gets to choose whether they want to be home or away.

Championship Games - All the same game time limits and tie breaker rules apply to the championship games with the exception that at least 5 full innings must be played regardless of the time limit. After championship games, a brief awards ceremony will occur at the tournament tent.

All other regular season rules apply if not listed here. All teams will play at least 2 games.

There will be a central tournament status area where you can check on game scores and times and who you play next. Please turn in your score here after each game.
